First Trimester: Animal Farm/Screwtape Letters

This course is taught using the total language plus focus guides for Animal Farm and The Screwtape Letters. These study guides are essential and can be purchased on www.Christianbook.com or www.rainbowresource.com.

Students are expected to read the novel and complete their study guides for each unit prior to class. We will be following the planning guide inside the TLP guide. Some enrichment activities will be done together in class as well as going over completed work. Pictures, pen and paper, personal thinking and projects will be assigned throughout the trimester. Each student is expected to come to class with their completed work, a notebook and pencil. They will be expected to be prepared to answer questions and participate in class discussion and activities.

Week 1: We will begin with Animal Farm. Please have the following assignments finished when class begins.

Complete the pre-reading activities, Read Chapters 1-4 and answer the questions. Complete essay question from chapter 1 and choose an essay question to complete for chapter 4.

Week 2: Read chapters 5-8. Answer questions from chapters 5-8. Do essay question from chapter 5. Start writing an essay for chapter 8 (be sure to follow the guidelines). Chapter 8 essay will be due NEXT week (week 3)

Week 3: Read chapters 9- 10. Answer questions from chapters 9-10. Chapter 8 essay due. Start writing final essay. Final essay will be due next week (Week 4).

Week 4: Final essays due. Game week!

Week 5: Movie week! Get to class asap, and we will be watching through lunch.

Week 6: Read the preface-letter 12. Lessons 1-5 due. This includes the Define what you believe section as well.

Week 7: Read letters 13-24. Lessons 6-10 due. Complete each Define what you believe section and the "Letter" section from lesson 8. Be sure you are completing every section of the lessons.

Week 8: Read letters 25-31. Lessons 11-16 due. Final apologetics paper due next week

Week 9: Final Apologetics paper due! Game week!
